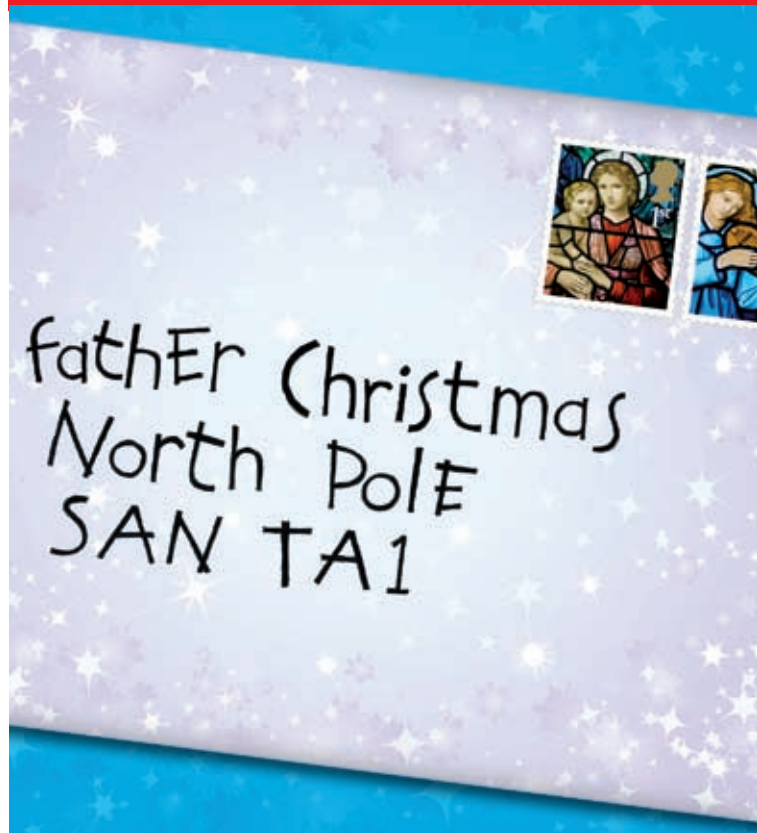

- Write the address clearly and correctly
- Double check the postcode (visit www.royalmail.com/postcodes if you are unsure)

And remember, if your card is larger than 240mm x 165mm x 5mm, then you need to use a large letter stamp.
